NOTICE

Delhi State Legal Services Authority invites applications in the prescribed format via email from Advocates/ Retired Judicial Officers/ Teachers/ Civil Servants/ Defence Officers/ Police Officers and like besides Social Workers for empanelment against requirement of about 100 Counsellors.

Please read the following instructions carefully before sending the application-

- Format of Application with details of terms & conditions is available on the website of DSLSA i.e. www.dlsa.nic.in
- **Only Soft copy** of application complete in all respect in the prescribed format alongwith the scanned copies of documents as mentioned at S. No. 10 in the format of application be sent to e-mail address legalaidwing-dslsa@nic.in from your own e-mail IDs
- The candidates shall affix their coloured photograph on the application format which should not exceed **75 kb** in .jpg format, if being sent by email.
- A candidate shall submit only one application.
- Only those candidates who fulfil the eligibility criteria may apply for empanelment.
- Please mention your contact number (mobile & land line) and email address.
- The candidate must give all required particulars in the application form and no column should be left blank else the application would not be considered.
- The last date for submission of application is **30.04.2014**.

A. Desirable Eligibility Criteria –

The applicant who possess the following eligibility and experience would be preferred for empanelment with Delhi State Legal Services Authority:-

- Degree of Law with 5 years standing at the Bar on the date of this Notification.
- Diploma or Degree Course in Social Science, Social Work, Psychology, or like with experience of working with any NGO or any Social Organisation.
- Retired Judicial Officers/ Civil Servants (Ex. IAS, IPS & DANIC), Defence Officers/ Teachers/ Police Officers (ACP and above) and like besides Social Workers can also apply.

B. Selection Procedure -

1. No applicant shall be called for interview unless he/she satisfies the eligibility conditions.
2. Merely fulfilling the eligibility criteria will not confer any right on applicant to be called for interview or selection.
3. Depending upon the applications received and the requirement of DSLSA, the Authority reserves the right to short list the applicant to be called for the Interview.
4. No individual intimation will be sent to any applicant for appearing in the interview. A list of short listed applicant with the date, time and venue of Interview will be displayed on the website www.dlsa.nic.in by **10.05.2014**.
5. The applicant shall bring original documents at the time of interview.
6. Interview Board will take into consideration the commitment, experience, and professional acumen of the candidate while making selection.
7. The empanelment result will be displayed on our website **www.dlsa.nic.in**.

C. Terms and Conditions For Empanelment -

1. Tenure of the Panel shall be 3 years.
2. Empanelment of a Counsellor with Authority would not make him/her entitled to any remuneration. Counsellors would be paid only for the work rendered as per approved fee schedule.
3. The Authority reserves the right to avail the services of empanelled Counsellors to perform duties in Legal Services Clinics, Gender Resource Centres, Jails, Observation Homes, Legal Literacy Clubs, Schools, Colleges, Front Office of DLSAs etc. and also for other activities/awareness programmes.
4. Removal from Panel: If performance of the empanelled Counsellor is found unsatisfactory or the Counsellor is found to be involved in charging or collecting or demanding any remuneration from any person in any form or is found involved in any other misconduct or he/she contravenes the Scheme of the Act, Rules and the Regulations, he/she can be summarily removed from the panel and shall also be liable for action for professional misconduct as per Regulation 7 of the Delhi State Legal Services Authority Regulations, 2002.
5. The Authority reserves its rights to enlarge the scope of the duty of the empanelled Counsellor in order to achieve the aim and object of “The Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987” and its Rules, Regulations, etc.
